The Future Titans Prescient Fund has a flexible mandate to invest in a range of asset classes but will typically have high exposure to companies outside of the Top 40 Index. The fund is permitted to invest 25% offshore plus an additional 5% in Africa. The primary objective of the fund is to achieve real long-term capital growth ahead of CPI + 6%. The fund looks to acquire fast growing, mispriced, mid-and small-cap shares, "Future Titans", on the back of high conviction

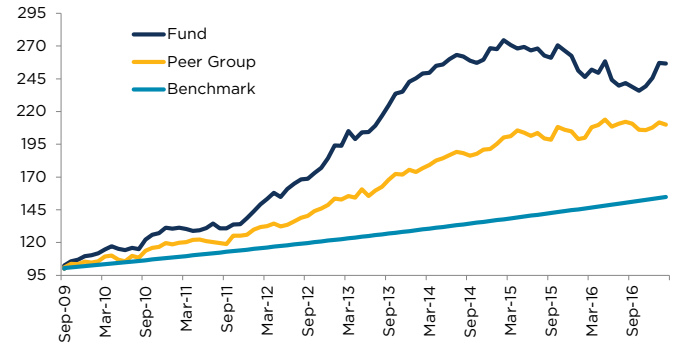
WHO SHOULD INVEST

MONTHLY COMMENTARY

Future Titans return -0.18% in the month of Feb against the Flexible Index return of -0.79%, the JSE All Share return of -3.11%.

The Rand continued to strengthen, gaining 4.57% against the Euro in the month. This had a negative effect on the fund's largest holding, Sirius Real Estate - Sirius was up over 3% in London but down 3% in South Africa.

Hulamin delivered a stunning result with earnings up 222% driven by operational efficiencies which produced a record 232 000 tons of production in 2016 versus 198 000 tons last year. The company unveiled some exciting growth plans targeting R1.63 in earnings by 2019 versus the current R1.19. Importantly, cash generation remained strong and if continued should result in a reduction of debt levels to zero over the next two years. Hulamin's share of aluminum slugs, which supply SAB/Nampak, will move from 50% to 70% over the next two years and the company will start earning automotive export credits from Tesla, their largest client. Hulamin is currently the cheapest industrial on the JSE with a current PE ratio of 5.5x versus AMAG of Austria's 31x PE. Wescoal announced the purchase of Keaton Energy which when the earnings are normalized and annualized put Wescoal on a PE ratio of 5.0x.

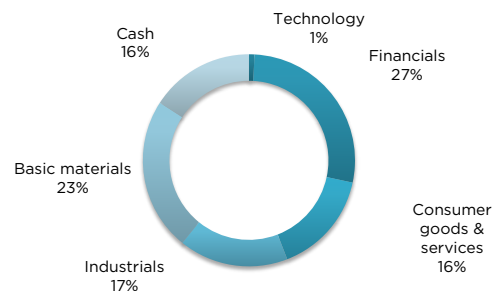

It should not be considered in isolation as returns may be impacted by many other factors over time including market returns, the type of Fund, investment decisions of the investment manager and the TER.

Where a current yield has been included for Funds that derive its income primarily from interest bearing income, the yield is a weighted average yield of all underlying interest bearing instruments as at the last day of the month.
